6. Pedestrian Walkway on upper Beacon and Kensington
 - a. Provide Overview: Robyn Rudge has been working with the city, for 5+ years, to make the catwalk out of the school property onto Upper Beacon safer for walking students. The city finally approved a painted walkway along the north side of upper Beacon and Kensington. A

city representative met with Neighbors whose homes would be affected by the painted walkway. There was overwhelming frustration and aggressive behavior towards the city rep. As a result, the city rep has paused the project.
